**FINAL JUDGMENT**

---

This matter was tried from October 2, 2017 through October 6, 2017, and October 10, 2017 through October 11, 2017, before an empaneled jury of twelve, Judge Richard P. Matsch, presiding.

After the evidence was closed and hearing the arguments and statements of counsel, the Court denied defendants' oral motions for judgment as a matter of law pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 50.

The trial proceeded to conclusion and the jury rendered its verdict. Pursuant to the jury verdict, plaintiff Robert Mark Smith will have and recover damages in the amount of \$350,250 from defendants Todd Willson, Scott Spade, and Town of Kremmling, Colorado jointly and severally, punitive damages in the amount of \$254,170 from defendant Todd Willson, and punitive damages in the amount of \$175,170 from defendant Scott Spade. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that post judgment interest shall accrue at the legal rate of 1.33% from the date of entry of this judgment. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that plaintiff's claims against defendant Robert Dillon are dismissed with prejudice.
